Hi Kinfolks!

On 11 June 1972, the descendants of NATHAN COWARD gathered at Jane and Dot's cabin at Norton, N. C., for a family reunion. This was the 81st family reunion and the 154th anniversery of the birth of Nathan Coward. A large crowd was in attendance, but there were many who could not attend this year - I being one who would have liked very much to have been there. It is always a happy occasion because this family has always had strong bonds of love.

NATHAN COWARD was born 12 June 1818, the son of Jonathan Coward and Martha Hudson Coward. He had several brothers/sisters: James, Betsy, Nancy, Jonathan, Jenny, Elihu, Polly, Hudson, Benjamin, and Mattie*. Nathan Coward was married twice. His first marriage was to Jane Rogers, daughter of David Rogers and Mary (Polly) Berry Rogers. His second wife was Sophia Hedden. By his first marriage, he had ten children: 1. Minerva Emeline: Coward, 2-Clara Almira Coward, Tolvin Berry Coward, 4-Jonathan David Coward, 5-Martha Samantha Coward, 6-Mary Alice Coward, 7-Oscar Boman Coward, 8-John Hamilton Coward, 9-Sallie Jane Coward, 10-Robert Rogers Coward. Four children were born to Nathan Coward and wife Sophia: 1-John Homer Coward, 2-Frances Emeline Coward, 3-Benjamin Frank Coward, 4-Jane Hedden Coward.

It was decided at the reunion this year that future reunions would be held on the third Sunday in June, rather than the second Sunday. This should make it easier for those families who have children in school to attend.

It was decided at the reunion that an appropriate headstone be placed at the gravesite of Nathan Coward and Jane Rogers Coward, where their remains lie in the Coward Cemetary in the Caney Fork Creek Section of Jackson County, N. C. Jane Coward, the youngest child of Nathan Coward, has selected a stone, the cost of which is \$586. As of the present time, contributions of \$245.00 have been received. If you have not contributed, will you do so? Make your checks payable to the "Nathan Coward Memorial Fund". Several people have donated \$25. (These two are cousins, both being great-grandchildren of Nathan Coward.) Rebecca (Becky) is the dau. of Mr. and Mrs. Conrad Hooper. Conrad is superintendent of Raleigh City Schools, and I can tell you he has a demanding job, which he handles very, very well. His mother Woodie Zachary Hooper was also here for the wedding. She is a granddaughter of Nathan Coward, as most of you know.

I am still working on the family history, which is taking me longer than I had planned to get it in book form, but - if the good Lord is willing - I will get it completed sometime in the future. In the meantime, it occurred to me that a family newsletter might be nice to carry current news about members of the family as well as interesting facts about our forebears.
